Update on David – David's soccer success was again featured in The Daily News Longview newspaper. Reporters from Channel 2 news attended his last soccer game and did a short spot on their evening news the next day. We met with doctors at Portland Shriners on Oct. 30. They will begin treatments on his club foot in January or February. They suggested it may take up to 18 months to complete. We just got the confirmation from Immigration to extend his visa until July 2007. We will apply to extend it again so David can remain for all his treatments. David is doing well in first grade. His English is improving all the time. Wish I could say the same for my Spanish!!

Container Report - The container has suffered several delays due to paperwork. As I write this the current hope is that it will arrive in Honduras on November 23rd. However, I am not holding my breath. The hold up is in Miami due to the loads of documents needed to allow the tractor out of the country. Hopefully I will have great news of its arrival in the Nov./Dec. newsletter. Thanks again to all of you who made this possible!!

Meeting with the First Lady On October 5th Serranos met with the First Lady's cabinet. She had been called away to attend to the victims of a Women's Shelter fire in which 6 women and 3 children died. Her cabinet assured Serranos that she will be visiting our Children's Village soon. They also met with the Minister of Education. He has pledged books and homeschooling materials for our Village.

Copan Conference – Serrano's, Frenter's and Olsen's attended the Conference on Honduras 2006 in Copan Oct. 11-14. A presentation of Worldwide Heart to Heart Ministries was given to the approximately 250 participants from all over the world. It was a great opportunity to meet and network with other humanitarian groups working in Honduras. The following week they spent time with the children at our village, met with our new Honduras Board of Directors and helped several of our children celebrate their October birthdays at Salomon Lopez's Water and Animal Park nearby. Salomon treated us to free entry to the park. What a great place!!!
